Blooming Pencil

WRITE • ERASE • GROW

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS



Remove the Eraser

Gently pull off the eraser from the pencil. Twist or open the eraser to access the seeds inside.



Prepare Your Soil

Fill a small pot with compost or use a garden bed. Lightly water so the soil is moist (not soaking).



Sow the Seeds

Sprinkle the seeds evenly onto the soil surface. Cover lightly with a thin layer of compost (approx. 2-3 mm).



Water & Place

Water gently and place in a warm, bright spot. Avoid direct harsh sunlight while seeds are germinating.



Watch Them Grow

Keep soil moist but not waterlogged. Seedlings should appear within 1-3 weeks depending on the variety.



Let Them Bloom

Once established, move to a sunnier position. Enjoy your flowers as they grow and bloom!

Helpful Tips

- Best sown: Spring to early Summer
- Works great in pots, window boxes, or garden beds
- Thin seedlings if crowded for stronger growth

Important

Do not plant the pencil. Only the seeds from the eraser are intended for growing.
